Caracalla (188/211-217) is Rome's last emperor buried in Rome (Castel Sant'Angelo).

Caracalla's mother, Julia Domna († 217 CE), is the last empress buried in Rome (Augustus Mausoleum).

Caracalla's successor, Elagabal (204/218–222), is the last emperor taking residence on the Palatine in Rome.

In the 254 years between 222 and 476 (common date for the end of the West-Roman Empire) no emperor ever had a palace or a tomb in Rome.

Some 77 barracks emperors of Rome (235-285) plus 65 Roman emperors dated 285-476, thus a total of 142 Roman emperors did neither take residence nor got buried in Rome.
