

Caracalla (188/211-217) is Rome's **last emperor buried** in Rome (Castel Sant'Angelo).

Caracalla's mother, Julia Domna († 217 CE), is the **last empress buried** in Rome (Augustus Mausoleum).

Caracalla's successor, Elagabal (204/218–222), is the **last emperor taking residence** on the Palatine in Rome.

In the **254 years** between 222 and 476 (common date for the end of the West-Roman Empire) **no emperor** ever had a palace or a tomb **in Rome**.

Some 77 barracks emperors of Rome (235-285) plus 65 Roman emperors dated 285-476, thus a total of **142 Roman emperors did neither take residence nor got buried in Rome**.
